

How Will You Paint Your Gorilla?



How to Paint Your Gorilla

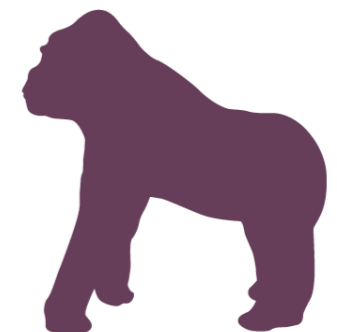
- Plan your design using the gorilla template.
- When you are ready to start painting, cover your work area e.g. with old newspaper.
- Part fill a cup with water.
- Carefully stir the paints.
- Wash the brush in the water before using a new colour.
- Allow the paint to dry fully before painting over it.

Some Suggestions

- Put stickers on the ceramic, paint over them and pick them off with a pin before the paint dries (be careful!).
- Try swirling wet paints together or scraping through a layer of wet paint over a layer of dried paint.
- When all the paints are dry you can add stickers, glitter or threads to your design.
- Draw over dry paint with metallic pens or stick pictures on with PVA glue.

Paints and Mixing

- Add a little dab of water to the paints for easy application.
- You can mix the colours to make more colours or different shades e.g. yellow and red will make orange.
- You can add white to lighten or black to darken the paint shade you want. Just add a little bit of paint at a time, particularly of black. Mix the paints with your brush and then add some more if you want to.
- Paints will usually wash off with warm water unless they have dried.
- When you finish leave your gorilla to dry somewhere warm overnight.
